Dear Colleagues,

When GIRP changed the English version of its name to the 'European Healthcare Distribution Association' in November 2015, the change reflected not only a widened assortment of products from RX and OTC medicinal products to medical devices, food supplements and all products sold in pharmacies; it also represented an evolution and expansion in the role and function of pharmaceutical wholesalers. Today, full-line pharmaceutical wholesalers no longer function as mere 'box movers'; they have altered and adapted their business models to offer a broad range of value-added services to the pharmaceutical industry, pharmacies, and of course, to patients.

With this spirit in mind, we selected 'Healthcare Distribution: A Vision for the Future' as the theme for this year's 57<sup>th</sup> GIRP Annual Meeting and Conference in Noordwijk, the Netherlands. Also scheduled for the afternoon is a colourful and enlightening mix of presentations on adaptive pathways to medicines access, on medicines supply to hospitals and on enabling access to medicines worldwide. We are pleased to again welcome our longtime friend, partner and supporter, Mr. Per Troein, Vice President Strategic Alliances from IMS Health to Noordwijk this year.

On the second conference day, a keynote address from the European Commission on the safety of medicines will set the stage for an ensuing discussion on how the various partners in the supply chain are collaborating to accomplish the aims and provisions of the Delegated Regulation of the Falsified Medicines Directive. Thereafter we will take a closer look at the 'Pharmacy as a Healthcare Centre' and examine new and innovative means of ensuring pharmacy sustainability under growing economic strain and pressure. As many of our members are integrated healthcare distribution companies, this session will offer new ideas and solutions to address old and emerging challenges. In a concluding session we will explore how the vision of sustainable partnerships in the pharmaceutical supply chain can be strategically realised and implemented.

Accompanying this stimulating conference programme are a number of social activities, set in and around our beautiful coastal venue, to which we cordially invite you.

As President of GIRP, I look forward to personally welcoming you at our 57<sup>th</sup> Annual Meeting and Conference and to what will surely be a memorable event in Noordwijk!

#### VISIT OF THE HAGUE AND DELFT

During this tour you will visit two cities that have played a crucial role in the history of the Netherlands: The Hague and Delft. The visit starts at the Mauritshuis in The Hague. This quaint little museum situated in the heart of The Hague reopened after being renovated in the summer 2014 and is home to a compact, yet world-renowned collection of Dutch Golden Age (17th century) paintings. Masterpieces such as "Girl with a Pearl Earring" by Vermeer, "Anatomy Lesson of Dr. Nicolaes Tulp" by Rembrandt, "The Goldfinch" by Fabritius and "The Bull" by Potter are on permanent display.

Next on the agenda is a visit of Delft, a city known for its canals and many almshouses in the historic city centre. Here we will visit the Royal Dutch Delftware Manufactory "De Porceleyne Fles". The factory was established in 1653 and is the last remaining Delftware factory from the  $17^{\text{th}}$  century. Delftware porcelain originated in China and is still hand-painted according to a century old tradition.
